
Coös County Commuting Patterns



Working in Coös County

- An average of 14,383 commuters age 16 and over travel to work in Coös County.
- Among commuters traveling to work in Coös County, 85.3 percent (12,266) also live in Coös County, 6.8 percent (982) live in another New Hampshire county, and 7.9 percent (1,135) live out-of-state.
- Over half (53.6 percent) of the workers commuting into Coös County from elsewhere live out-of-state, and out of those workers, 68.3 percent live in Vermont. Nearly all of the commuters from Vermont live in Essex County, the northeast corner of that state.
- Among the 982 workers commuting into Coös County from another New Hampshire county, 45.9 percent live in Grafton County and 32.2 percent live in Carroll County.

Residents of Coös County

- An average of 15,166 Coös County residents age 16 and over commute to work.
- Among the Coös County residents who commute to work, 80.9 percent (12,266) travel

- to a job in Coös County, 12.6 percent (1,912) travel to another New Hampshire county, and 6.5 percent (988) travel out-of-state.
- Of Coös County residents who travel to another New Hampshire county for work, 64.3 percent commute to Grafton County and 21.3 percent commute to Carroll County.
- Among Coös County residents commuting outof-state, 59.2 percent work in Vermont, and 15.5 percent work in Massachusetts.
- Three-fourths (76.4 percent) of Coös County residents who commute to Vermont work in Essex County (Canaan area).

Coös County, NH In-County Commuters

- There are 12,266 residents of Coös County age 16 and over who commute to work within the county.
- Among those who both live and work in Coös County, 32.9 percent commute to jobs in Berlin, 13.3 percent commute to Gorham, 12.8 percent commute to Lancaster, and 8.3 percent commute to jobs in Colebrook.



About the American Community Survey

The American Community Survey (ACS) is an ongoing survey conducted by the US Census Bureau, designed to provide more current data than available through a decennial Census. Commuting data were compiled from ACS survey responses gathered over a five-year period, from 2006 to 2010. Respondents were asked if they worked, where they worked, and how long it usually took for them to go from home to work, among other questions.
