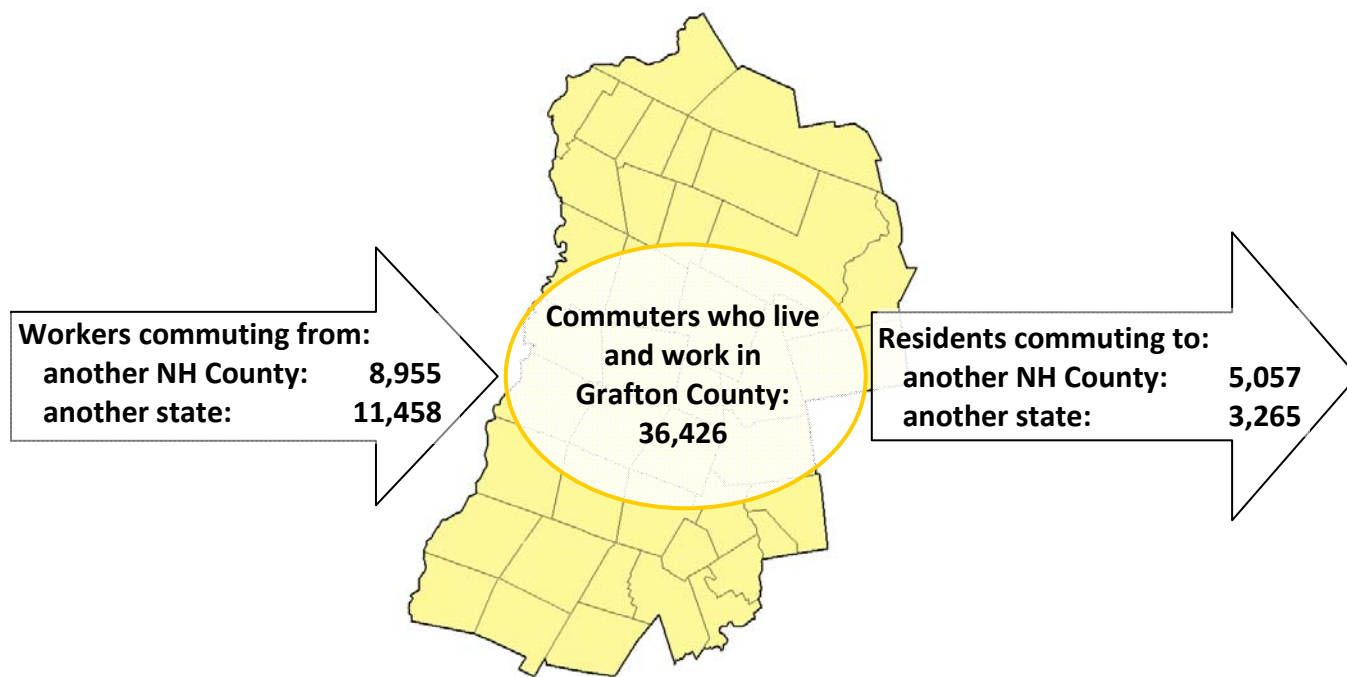


# Grafton County Commuting Patterns



## Working in Grafton County

- An average of 56,839 commuters age 16 and over travel to work in Grafton County.
- Of all workers who travel to jobs in Grafton County, 64.1 percent (36,426) also live in Grafton County, 15.8 percent (8,955) live in some other New Hampshire county, and 20.2 percent (11,458) live out-of-state.
- Over half (53.2 percent) of workers commuting into Grafton County from out of the county live in Vermont. Most of those commuters live in Windsor, Orange, or Caledonia counties, which border Grafton County.
- Of the workers who commute to jobs in Grafton County from another New Hampshire county, 45.6 percent live in Sullivan County, 17.6 percent live in Merrimack County, and 13.7 percent live in Coös County.

## Residents of Grafton County

- An average of 44,748 Grafton County residents age 16 and over commute to work.
- Among Grafton County's working residents, 81.4 percent (36,426) commute to a job in

Grafton County, 11.3 percent (5,057) commute to another New Hampshire county, and 7.3 percent (3,265) commute out-of-state.

- Of Grafton County residents commuting out of the county for work, 60.8 percent travel to another New Hampshire county. Nearly two-thirds of workers commuting in-state travel to either Belknap County (35.5 percent) or Merrimack County (29.4 percent).
- Among the Grafton County residents who commute out of state for work, 77.9 percent travel to Vermont.

## Grafton County, NH In-County Commuters

- There are 36,426 residents of Grafton County age 16 and over who commute to work within the county.
- Among those who both live and work in Grafton County, 27.1 percent travel to jobs in Lebanon, 16.2 percent live in Hanover, 10.1 percent live in Plymouth, and 9.1 percent live in Littleton.

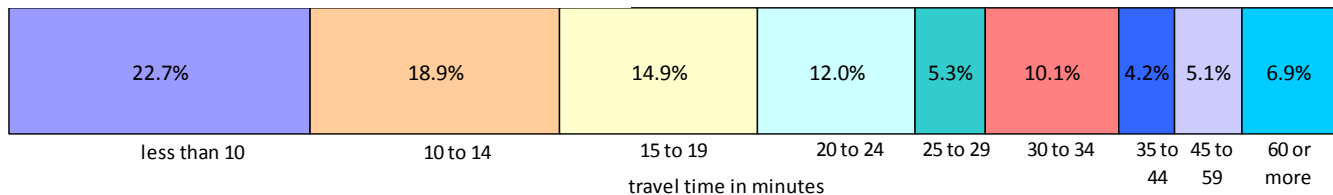

### About the American Community Survey

The American Community Survey (ACS) is an ongoing survey conducted by the US Census Bureau, designed to provide more current data than available through a decennial Census. Commuting data were compiled from ACS survey responses gathered over a five-year period, from 2006 to 2010. Respondents were asked if they worked, where they worked, and how long it usually took for them to go from home to work, among other questions.
